Mom and Dad went to look for the pet cat. They **looked** and **looked**, and so did the boy, but they saw no cat.

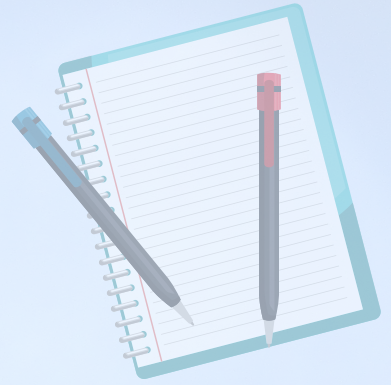




